Chief Umpire: Mike Bagshawe

As stated in the RCA Rules of Racing (Section 11.11), the Chief Umpire is responsible for the application of the Rules of Racing to a sanctioned regatta and shall uphold the principles of safety, fair competition and good sportsmanship.

Safety Officer: John Earle

As stated in the RCA Rules of Racing (Section 8.2), the focus of the Safety Advisor is to ensure that appropriate safety measures have been implemented for the safe running of the regatta and observe any breaches of safety practices during the regatta.

First Aid/Medical Officer: TBC

As stated in the RCA Rules of Racing (Section 8.3), the Organizing Committee shall appoint a qualified person as the regatta Medical Advisor with specific responsibilities for ensuring that appropriate medical support and facilities are readily accessible to the regatta. First aid facilities on land at the regatta site and a rescue service on the water must be available at all times.

IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

Charge Person: Glen Stiven

This individual will take control of the situation and activate other components of the Emergency Action Plan.

Call Person: Algis Masys

This individual will call for emergency help, provide all necessary information to dispatch, ensure that emergency vehicles will be able to access the required location on site.

Available safety equipment:

4 safety boats, an AED, 4 radios

In the case of an on-water emergency, the following protocols will be followed: Safe havens-

Vernon Rowing and Dragon Boat Club 7730 Lochdale Rd. The cross street is Elmwood Rd. Harper House 8131 Old Kamloops Rd

Swan Lake Campground 7235 Old Kamloops Rd Public Boat Launch Meadowlark Rd

In the case of a medical emergency, the following protocols will be followed:

Notify First Aid Provider, call 911, clear area around incident, station a volunteer at gate.
